Philip Ursprung, Professor for History of Art and Architecture at ETH Zürich will be exploring the interface between art and architecture looking at the work of Olafur Eliasson, Peter Zumthor and Herzog de Meuron; followed by a discussion panel with Rachel Kent, Senior Curator/ MCA, and others. Professor Jonathan Hill, Professor for Architecture and Visual Theory at the Bartlett School of Architecture, University College London, critically re-evaluates contemporary responses to climate change by analysing the weather's effects on the design and experience of specific buildings and external environments.
